# **Bonds proposed for clean energy**

The state would pump \$1.3 billion a year into renewable energy, such as solar, wind and geothermal, under a proposed amendment to the Ohio Constitution. A group called yes for Ohio's Energy Future submitted a petition with the signatures of 3,330 voters to Attorney General Mike DeWine on Friday. A minimum of 1,000 valid signatures is required for approval of ballot language.
